You will need your personal code and pin number to access them (you used this to upload your EE and IAs); if you cannot locate this information, please email Ms Aherne at aherne@danecourt.kent.sch.uk who will remind you. Please try to do this before 4th July as the 5th and 6th are very busy days for her and you would not want a delay in receiving a reminder.

When you collect your results, which will include your level per subject, core results and overall point score (diploma only) and whether or not the diploma or IBCP has been awarded, if you need to speak to a member of staff about any concerns including your results and your plans for September, please email Ms Roe at croe@danecourt.kent.sch.uk who will ensure that you are put in contact with the right person to help. We can speak to you on the phone, communicate via email but will also be making appointments, upon your request, to see students in person on Tuesday 7th and Wednesday 8th, if you should wish. Please note that your component marks do not arrive with you or the school, until 7th July.
