DCGS Sixth Form Dress Code

As a student of DCGS sixth form you are expected to dress in an appropriate manner which follows the guidance below. Failure to meet these expectations may result in you being sent home to correct your outfit or a re-drafting of this dress code to incorporate a more formal style. In cases of dispute about what is appropriate the Head of Sixth Form will be the final arbiter.

Acceptable items of clothing:

- Jeans (without rips)
- Smart (chino/tailored) shorts
- T-shirts (with no offensive logos)
- Jumpers (with no offensive logos)
- Hoodies (with no offensive logos)
- Dresses
- Skirts (at least mid-thigh in length)
- Tights
- Trousers

Unacceptable items of clothing:

- Vests
- Strapless tops
- Jogging bottoms/leisure-wear trousers
- Low-rise trousers
- Ripped jeans
- Sports/Jersey/Denim shorts
- Short skirts (above mid-thigh)
- Crop tops
- Hats
- Any item with offensive logos displayed

Footwear:

No flip flops/sandals

Jewellery:

No facial jewellery (except studs)

Please note that a number of 'dress-smartly days' will be held across the year when you will be expected to come to school in formal office wear.
